This is an application under section 483 of B.N.S.S. praying for bail filed by the accused as against the rejection order of the Ld. Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate Islampur in connection with **Karandighi P.S. case no. 228/2026**, Dated 20.05.2026, U/S- 310(4)/310(5) of BNS, r/w section 25(1A)/27/35 of Arms Act, pending before Ld. ACJM, Islampur.

Received the LCR and the CD.

The case record is being taken up for hearing.

Heard Ld. Addl. P. P. and Ld. Counsel for the accused/petitioners.

Ld. Advocate for the accused/petitioners submits that no application of a similar nature was/is preferred before the Higher forum nor a similar nature of the application was rejected.

On query, Ld Addl P P submits that there is no reflection in the CD that there is any bail application either pending or rejected by the Hon'ble High Court and IO also did not intimate him that any bail application is pending or rejected by the Hon'ble High Court.

Ld Advocate for the accused/petitioner submitted that the accused/petitioners have been falsely implicated in the case and they are in custody since 20.05.2026 in this case. It is further submitted that investigation has considerably been progressed and there is no chance of abscondment of the accused petitioners from the process of law. Hence, prayed for bail of accused petitioners on any condition.

Ld Addl P.P. raised objection.

Heard. Considered.

Perused the bail petition, the case record and the CD and comparing the same with the statement of witnesses, it appears that the accused petitioners are in custody since 20.05.2026 and the accused petitioners were already taken into police custody. It further appears that by this time investigation has considerably been progressed as seizure has already been made.

Considering the above facts and circumstances of the case, I do not find any reason to justify further detention of the petitioners any more.

Accordingly, petition u/s 483 of B.N.S.S. stands **allowed**.

Hence, the accused/petitioners namely, **1. Md. Naved Asraf Quadri, 2. Sajid Alam, 3. Mir Masud Alam, and 4. Izahar Reja Noori** may find bail of Rs. 3,000/- each with two sureties of Rs. 1,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of Ld. A.C.J.M., Islampur and on condition that the petitioners shall not intimidate or induce any witness of this case with a further condition that the accused petitioners shall meet the I.O once in a week till completion of investigation.

Let a copy of this order along with L.C.R. be sent to the office of the Ld. Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Islampur for information and taking necessary action.

CD be returned.
