File put up before me being Vacation Judge during summer vacation.

Today ASI Charanjit Singh has come present and suffered following statement:-

“Stated that present FIR has been registered for the offences punishable under section 115(2), 191(3), 190, 351(3) & 133 of BNS and all above said offences are bailable in nature and no other offence has been added in this case till date. However opinion of the doctor qua the injuries on the person of complainant is kept pending”.

Moreover, no bail application of the applicant- accused has been decided by this court. No such bail application has been decided by the Hon’ble High court or is pending before the Hon’ble High court, in this case. However, no other criminal case has been registered against applicant-accused except the present case.

Learned counsel for applicant-accused has also suffered following statement:-

“I have heard the statement of ASI Charanjit Singh and in view of the above said statement, I do not want to proceed further with this bail application and same may please be dismissed as withdrawn. However, prior notice may be issued in case any further offence is added after receipt of opinion of doctor”.

In view of the above said statements, present bail application is dismissed as withdrawn. However, in case any further offence is added after receipt of opinion of doctor, the Investigating Agency is directed to give three days prior notice to applicant-accused to apply for anticipatory bail in case, he is required to be arrested in this case. File be consigned to the record room.
