This is an application for grant of interim bail filed u/s 483 BNSS (439 Cr.PC) for a period of 15 days on behalf of applicant/accused namely Ombir.

Arguments heard.

It is contended by the Ld. Counsel that the applicant/accused is innocent and that he has been falsely implicated in this case. That the cousin sister of the applicant/accused namely Madhu died on 14.09.2025 and that her tehrnvi is scheduled for 13th day of the death. That the applicant was adopted by the said family as they were not having any male child in their family. That the presence of the applicant is required for the said tehrnvi.

The application is opposed by the Ld. Addl. PP for the State/IO on the ground that the allegations against the applicant/accused are serious in nature. That there are two more brothers of the applicant, who are available at home and can perform the aforesaid ritual.

This is an admitted fact that the applicant is not the real brother of the deceased namely Madhu. This is also not in dispute that the applicant has two more brothers, who are major. Accordingly, in these circumstances, I do not find any merits in the application as to why the presence of the applicant only is

required when admittedly, there are two more brothers of the applicant available. Moreover, the allegations against the applicant/accused are serious in nature.

Accordingly, no ground is made out. I am not inclined to grant bail to the applicant/accused. Hence, the application is **dismissed**.
