ORDER

Police record produced.

Heard on the bail application filed by the accused/applicant Satya Devi for the offences under Sections 420/466/468/471/474/120B of IPC.

In this application, it is submitted that accused has been falsely implicated in the present case. She is in judicial custody and no more required by the police for further investigation. It is further submitted that applicant is not having any involvement in this case. The presentation of challan and conclusion of trial will take time. As such, learned counsel for accused/applicant has prayed for release of accused/applicant on bail.

Notice being served, learned APP for the State, has opposed the bail application on the ground that accused has committed serious offences. As such, prayer for dismissal of the present bail application has been made.

I have heard the contradictory versions of the contesting parties and have deliberated over the arguments advanced in the light of documents, peculiar facts and circumstances and submissions made and gone through the judicial record.

Record perused. The present case has been registered against accused for the commission of offences punishable under Section 420/466/468/471/474/120B of IPC for committing the offence of cheating and forgery. The allegations leveled against accused are serious in nature and a specific role has been attributed to her in investigation. So, considering the gravity of offences involved in this case, I am of the view that accused is not entitled to the concession of bail in this case as there is every apprehension that after being enlarged on bail accused will tamper with the evidence and will influence the witnesses. Accordingly the present bail application is ordered to be **dismissed**. Papers be attached with the main case file.
