ORDER

1) Vide this order, I shall dispose of the present bail application
filed by the accused/ applicant in the above mentioned case.

2) Ld.counsel for the applicant contended that the applicant/
accused is innocent. He has not committed any offence alleged by the
complainant. He contended that even at the time of occurrence, the
accused was not got identified by the complainant and as per the contents
of FIR, the complainant stated that he lateron came to know that the
present applicant/ accused alongwith his co-accused robbed Rs.25,000/-
from him. In the FIR itself, the source of his knowledge was not disclosed
and there is no evidence on record that under which circumstances, the
complainant has come to know that the robbery in the present case was
allegedly committed by the applicant/ accused. The case of the

prosecution is based on suspicion only. So, under such circumstances, at this stage, prima-facie there is no evidence against the applicant/ accused on file. With these submission, request for granting anticipatory bail has been made.

3) On the other hand, learned Addl.PP for the State has contested the arguments of ld.counsel for the applicant/ accused and contended that there are serious allegations against the applicant/ accused levelled by the complainant that he was robbed by the present applicant/ accused alongwith his co-accused and when the co-accused was caught hold by the people at the spot, he was got released by the remaining accused. The recovery of Rs.25,000/- is yet to be effected from the present applicant, as such, his custodial interrogation is required and request for dismissal of the bail application has been made.

4) Police record perused. The present FIR has been got registered on the statement of complainant Roshan Kumar, who stated that in the season rice crop and wheat crop, they used to do the labour work. In this session also, he alongwith son of his paternal aunt namely Shyam Kumar alongwith other labour is doing the work of labour in Raman Mandi under Arun Kumar. Arun Kumar is doing the work of commission agent at village Manawala also. He engaged the complainant and others for doing the work of labour in Mandi Manawala. Today at about 7.15 p.m., when he was near the bushes of railway line for natural call and having Rs.25,000/- in his pocket, which was given to him by Arun Kumar to take to Raman Mandi, two youngmen came there, one of them

caught hold of him from behind and the other person has robbed Rs.25,000/- from his pocket. However, he tried to save himself and they had given beatings to him with fist blows. When he raised Raula, Shyam Kumar and other labourers ran towards him and they caught hold one person and the other person ran away from the spot. While they were giving information to their commission agent Arun Kumar, three more persons having *Dande* in their hands and one lady came near to them and started giving beatings to them, in which Shyam Kumar and one more labourer received injuries and got released youngman who had been caught hold by them and taken him alongwith them and while leaving the place, they forcibly taken away his mobile make Vivo also. Thereafter, Shyam Kumar and other labourers were got admitted in the Hospital at Raman, who was lateron referred to Civil Hospital, Bathinda. On inquiry, it has come to the knowledge that the persons, who has robbed the money and snatched the mobile phone and caused injuries to them are the persons who were earlier doing labour work under Arun Kumar and the person, who robbed the money from him is Khushdeep Singh @ Tota, Gurpreet Singh @ Kali and the persons who snatched mobile phone and caused injuries are Gurwinder Singh @ Ginda, Khushpreet Singh @ Mangu and Karamjit Kaur. Hence the present has been got registered.

5) From the perusal of FIR, it reveals that as per FIR, the present applicant alongwith his co-accused had robbed Rs.25,000/- from the complainant Roshan Kumar. There are further allegations that applicant/ accused is having gang with co-accused, who came for their

rescue and got released the co-accused caught hold by other labourers after causing injury to one Shyam Kumar and one other labourer. The recovery is yet to be effected from the accused, so for this purpose, custodial interrogation of the accused/ applicant is required. So, keeping in view the seriousness and gravity of the offence, no ground is made out to use the discretion for granting anticipatory bail to the accused/ applicant. Hence, the instant bail application stands dismissed. File be consigned to the record room.
