An application under section 482 of B.N.S.S. Act, 2023 (sec.438 Cr.PC.) is filed by the accused/petitioners namely, **1.Nitu @ Neetu Gupta and 2.Pinki @ Priyanka Gupta**, who apprehend arrest, in connection with **Regent Park P.S. Case No.92/2026 dated 13.05.2026, u/s 80/103/3(5) BNS**, is taken up for hearing.

Learned Advocate for the accused/petitioners submits that no such application u/s. 482 of B.N.S.S. Act, 2023 (sec.438 Cr.PC.) is either rejected or pending before the Hon'ble High Court prior to this application.

Ld. Advocate on behalf of the accused/petitioners submits that the present accused/petitioners are innocent and have been falsely implicated in this case. As such, he prayed for anticipatory bail of the accused/petitioners.

Ld. P.P.-in-charge produces the case diary and raises objection to the prayer for anticipatory bail u/s 482 of B.N.S.S. Act, 2023 (sec.438 Cr.PC.) of the present accused/petitioners.

Heard both sides.

I have perused the instant application, the case diary and other materials on record, including the PM report available in the CD.

It appears that the nature of death of the victim was suicidal. The husband/principal accused of this case is already enlarged on bail. The present accused/petitioners are the in-laws of the victim. The materials available before the Court do not indicate the necessity of custodial interrogation of the present accused/petitioners in this case. **Accordingly, prayer for anticipatory bail u/s 482 of B.N.S.S. Act, 2023 (sec.438 Cr.PC.) of the accused/petitioners is allowed.**

The accused/petitioners, in the event of arrest, shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of **Rs.5,000/- each with two sureties of Rs.2,500/- each**, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer, subject to the compliance of the condition as laid down in sec. 482(2) B.N.S.S., 2023 (sec.438(2) Cr.PC.).

Thus, the Crl. Misc. Case is disposed of.
