

State Vs Pintu Kumar

ORDER :

Heard on the bail application filed on behalf of accused/applicant Pintu Kumar in case FIR No. 141 dated 17.01.2024, under Sections 303(2), 317(2) of BNS, P.S. Sri Anandpur Sahib. Notice of the application was given to the State through Ld.APP for the State and reply to the above application has been filed submitting therein that the offence alleged to be committed by the accused are serious in nature and if the accused is released on bail, he may tamper with the evidence and intimidate the witnesses.

Record perused. Perusal of the record shows that the accused/applicant is in judicial custody and no useful purpose will be served by keeping the accused in custody for indefinite period as the presentation of challan and the conclusion of trial will take time. Moreover, it is cardinal principal of the law ***bail is a rule and jail is an exception*** and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the accused behind the bars for any inordinate period. Accordingly, accused Pintu Kumar is admitted to bail on his furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount subject to following conditions:-

1. The accused/applicant shall not leave the country without prior permission of the court.
2. The accused/applicant shall attend the court on each and every date of hearing and shall comply with other conditions of the bond executed.
3. The accused/applicant shall not commit any offence similar to the offence, of which, he is accused or suspect of the commission of which he is suspected.
4. The accused/applicant shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him/her from disclosing such facts to the court or to any police officer or tamper with the evidence.
5. The accused/applicant and surety shall be bound to intimate the court as and when they change their given addresses.

The requisite bail/surety bonds have been furnished, which are accepted and attested. Release warrants be issued forthwith. Papers be tagged with the main file and put up the file on 16.12.2024 i.e. the date already fixed.
