Today is fixed for production and evidence.

Ld. P.P. files hazira and present.

The accused Golam Md. and Md. Naziz Ahsan are produced virtually from Islampur Sub-Correctional Home.

The rest seven accused persons on CB, are present on dock.

One witness namely Shri Tashi Phuntsok, then Ld. Magistrate is present before this Court and examined and cross examined as **PW-29** and discharged after cross examination by Ld. Advocate on behalf of the accused Sahadat Reza and Sardar Ahmed.

Cross examination on behalf of Noor Alam, Sah Alam, Sahid, Golam Mohammad and Saklen Mustaq is adopted.

Cross examination on behalf of accused Md. Najish Ahsan, Tousif Reza @ Rajbabu is declined.

No other witness is present today.

Ld. Advocate on behalf of the accused Gulam Mohammad files a bail petition.

Hd. Ld. Advocate for the accused as well as Ld. P.P. in charge.

The Ld. Advocate for the accused person submitted that the accused is innocent and falsely implicated in this case.

Ld. Addl. P.P. raised vehement objection.

Considering the gravity of the offence, social impact and also the stage of trial the bail application of the accused Golam Mohammad can not be considered at this stage, hence rejected.

Accused are be and as before. Prosecution is directed to take steps accordingly.
