The present petition for anticipatory bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioners Gyanti Devi @ Anita Devi and Sunita Devi apprehending their arrest in connection with Konch P.S. Case No.247/2018 registered for the offences punishable under sections 341, 323, 504, 506, 336, 307, 379, 34 of IPC.

It is stated in para 2 of the bail petition that no anticipatory or regular bail petition has been previously filed by the petitioners either before this court or before any higher court. It is also stated in para-3 of bail petition that petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Prosecution case, in brief, as per written report of the informant is that on 16.07.2018, the accused persons armed with rod, lathji-danda came at the house of informant and after making abusement, they assaulted him and further, petitioner Sajan Yadav took out Rs.20,000/- from the pocket of informant.

Heard Ld. counsel for the petitioners and the Ld. P. P. for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are innocent and have been falsely implicated in this case. He further submits that informant and petitioners are family members and also other co-accused persons have been granted anticipatory bail by this court vide A.B.P. No.3567/2018 and the case of these petitioners stand on better footing.

Learned P. P. for the State opposes the prayer of the petitioners for anticipatory bail.

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Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, I am not persuaded to enlarge the petitioners on anticipatory bail. The petitioners are directed to surrender in the court below and seek regular bail. Ld. Court below shall consider the regular bail petition of the petitioners on the point that petitioners are ladies and other co-accused persons have been granted anticipatory bail and injury being simple in nature and on the basis of material available on record.

Accordingly, the petition for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is **disposed of.**
