Today is fixed for appearance of the accused persons and consideration of charge.

All the four (4) accused persons on court bail, are present.

It appears from the order dated 14.07.2022 that although the charge sheet had been filed against 9 accused persons but the accused persons namely Gita Rani Das, Parimal Das, Malati Das were discharged from the case and cognizance of the offence was not taken against Promod Das and Murli Das.

Now, the case record is being taken up for consideration of charge.

Ld. Special P.P. and the Ld. Defence Counsel are present.

Ld Special P.P. opens the case by narrating the facts of the case and produces the documents and the statements of witnesses which he wishes to use against all the accused persons to substantiate the charges under sections 363/365/34 of the IPC r/w section 6 of the POCSO Act.

Perused the case record and the documents under section 173 of the Code of the Criminal Procedure.

On perusal of the materials in case record as well as documents under section 173 of the Code of the Criminal Procedure, it appears that there is sufficient reason to believe that all the accused are involved in the commission of offence punishable under section 363/365/34 of the IPC r/w section 6 of the POCSO Act.

Heard both sides.

There is no objection from the defence regarding framing of charge against the accused persons under the above sections of law. Accordingly, charges under section 363/365/34 of the IPC r/w section 6 of the POCSO Act against all the accused persons is framed as per section 228 of the Cr.P.C.

The content of Charges are read over and explained to the accused persons in their mother tongue to which they plead not guilty and claim to be tried.
