ORDER:

1. This order of mine will dispose of an application for regular bail moved by accused-applicant Baljit Kaur, in case FIR No. 34/2024 u/s. 224,225IPC, PS Jandiala on the averments that applicant is innocent and has been falsely implicated. Applicant is in custody since 17.2.2024. No useful purpose will be served by further detaining the accused behind bars. Conclusion of trial will take long time.

2. Notice of this bail application was given to the State, upon which, learned Additional PP for the State appeared and contested the same. Investigating Officer ASI Tejinder Singh appeared alongwith police record and his statement was recorded.

3. I have heard ld.counsel for the applicant-accused, ld. Addl.PP for the State and gone through the record very carefully.

4. Learned counsel for accused-applicant pressed for grant of bail on the ground that accused-applicant has not committed any offence. She has been falsely implicated in this case. Accused-applicant is in custody since her arrest on 17.2.2024. Applicant is no more required for further investigation. Conclusion of trial will take considerable time. No useful purpose would be served by detaining the accused-applicant in custody.

5. On the other hand, learned Additional PP has refuted above contentions on the ground that accused-applicant alongwith co-accused has committed heinous offence and prayed for dismissal of the bail application of applicant-accused.

6. Perusal of the investigation record reveals the fact that the present case was registered on the statement of R.C.Solanki , P/SI, Police Head Quarter West Kutch Bhuj, Gujrat that on 16.2.2024 after producing accused Jobanjit Singh in the court of Sh.Gurmohan Singh, ld.ASJ Amritsar in Case FIR No.41/2019 PS NCB, Amritsar u/ 8,21,27-A,29 and 60 of NDPS Act of commercial quantity, were taking him back to Palara Jail Kutch Bhuj, Gujrat. They were taking meal they stopped at Naaz Dhaba, Bundala G.T.Road. They opened handcuff of accused

Jobanjit Singh for taking meal.. When they were taking meal Accused Surinder Singh, Satbir Singh, Daljit Kaur and Baljit Kaur accused came there. They all encircled them while they were taking meal and entangled them in conversation and managed to escape Jobanjit Singh from custody and accused Jobanjit Singh fled away from the custody. They tried to trace him but they could not trace him. Accused Surinder Singh, Satbir Singh, Daljit Kaur and Baljit Kaur were arrested on 17.2.2024.

Allegations against accused Baljit Kaur are that she alongwith other accused cheated the police party and managed accused Jobanjit Singh to flee from custody of police. Accused -applicant Jobanjit Singh was arrested on 17.2.2024 and since then he is in custody. So, the allegations against the accused/applicant are grave and serious in nature.

7. Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances, gravity of offence and seriousness of the allegations, this Court is of considered view that accused-applicant does not deserve concession of bail. If accused/applicant is released on bail, then he may create hindrance in the trial and may induce and threat the witnesses. Consequently, present bail application for grant of regular bail moved by accused-applicant Baljit Kaur, is hereby dismissed. Record of bail application be consigned to the record room.
