ORDER:

1. This is **second** regular bail application U/s 439 of Cr.P.C filed
on behalf of **Harinder Singh** (hereinafter referred as **bail applicant**), in
the above said FIR.

2. **Notice** of the bail application was issued to the State through

3. The police record was requisitioned and perused. Report of Ahlmad has also received, vide which it is reported that no case in the present FIR case found on the website of Hon'ble High Court of Punjab & Haryana, Chandigarh.

4. I have **heard** the Ld. Addl.PP for the State and the Ld. Counsel for the bail applicant and gone through the court record with their kind assistance.

5. From the record, it comes out to surface that **Kamaljit kaur (complainant/informant)**, who is none else but the real sister of Paramjit Kaur (deceased) had set the police machinery into motion by way of suffering statement before police on 17.10.2021, on the basis of which FIR no.121 dated 17.10.2021 was registered U/s 306, 34 IPC originally against **Harinder Singh (husband/ bail applicant)**, Gurdeep Kaur (mother in law), Hardev Singh (father in law) of deceased.

6. From the FIR, it comes out to surface that the marriage of deceased was performed with Harinder Singh son of Hardev Singh in 2016 and at that time dowry articles as per the status of the family of deceased were given. The deceased stated to have been maltreated and harassed by

her in-laws family on account of demand of dowry and the marriage not been performed as per their expectations and they were raising demand of bullet motorcycle and she used to be given beatings on this account. Even the matter stated to have been intervened by the Panchayat but of no avail. The gold ornaments which were given to the deceased at the time of her marriage were also misappropriated by the in laws family of the deceased. On 16.10.2021, the complainant tried to telephonically contact deceased but her phone was coming switched off, therefore, the bail applicant stated to have been contacted and was asked about deceased and he told that deceased and his mother had an altercation and deceased after switching off her phone is lying in the room, therefore, complainant along with her other sister namely Gurdeep Kaur had drop in, in the matrimonial house of the deceased at village Chanarthal Kalan, where they had come to know that deceased had been admitted in Garg Mission Hospital Patiala, as she had consumed some poisonous substance, therefore duo had arrived in the said hospital, where they observed critical condition of deceased and on 16.10.2021 itself at about 6.30 PM, she breathe her last.

7. No doubt on presentation of report U/s 173 Cr.P.C against the bail-applicant, after framing of charge against accused, two witnesses i.e.

real sister of deceased, who set the police machinery into motion, stood examined as witnesses, but that does not amount to change in circumstances, when the regular bail application filed on behalf of the bail-applicant stood already dismissed by undersigned vide order dated 17.06.2022. Therefore, in such circumstances, undersigned is not inclined to grant regular bail to the bail-applicant, in view of second regular bail application.

8. On the basis of above observations, the second regular bail application filed on behalf of the bail-applicant stand **dismissed**.

9. The observations made by undersigned vide this Order will have no reflection on merits. Papers of bail application be consigned to the record room.
