ORDER

Record received. Arguments heard.

2. It is mentioned in the application that the accused/applicant is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is further averred that accused/applicant has not committed any offence as alleged in this FIR. It is further averred that accused/applicant was taken into custody by the police on 9.2.2018 and has been sent to judicial lock up. It is further averred that no recovery as alleged has been effected from the accused/applicant and he is no more required for any further investigation, as such, he may be granted regular bail.

3. Learned counsel for the accused/applicant while arguing in the lines of the application contended that application may be allowed and accused may be granted bail.

4. Conversely, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the

State submitted that accused/applicant has committed serious offence and as such he does not deserve the benefit of bail and application may kindly be dismissed.

5. Having heard the arguments, it has transpired that the accused/applicant was apprehended on 9.2.2018 and from his possession 15 grams heroin was recovered. Record further reveals that the accused/applicant is undergoing custody since 9.2.2018 and report of chemical examiner is yet to be received. Presentation of challan and conclusion of trial shall take considerable long time and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the accused/applicant behind bars for indefinite period, therefore, the bail application filed by accused/applicant is allowed and accused/applicant is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- with one surety in the like amount. Accordingly, bail application is allowed. Record be returned and bail application papers be tagged with the connected papers.
