ORDER:

1. File put up today before me being Judge on Duty as per
latest order of Ld.Sessions Judge, Amritsar, dated 30.4.2020, to deal
with urgent criminal matters, in compliance of order dated 29.4.2020
of Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court, Chandigarh, due to
outbreak of Novel Coronavirus(COVID-19).

2. This order of mine shall dispose of Ist bail application u/s.439 of Cr.P.C filed on behalf of accused-applicant for grant of regular bail.

3. The applicant/accused has filed the present bail application on the averments that he is innocent and has been falsely implicated. Applicant is no more required for further investigation. No offence has been committed by him. The conclusion of trial will take long time. Hence, this bail application.

4. Upon notice issued to State, Addl.PP for the State has appeared. Main file from the Court of Ld.Illaqa Magistrate has been received.

5. I have heard ld.counsel for the applicant/accused and ld.Addl.PP for the State through Video Conferencing as per latest order dated 28.4.2020 of ld.Sessions Judge, Amritsar and gone through the file very carefully.

6. Perusal of the file reveals that FIR in this case was registered on the basis of information that one party headed by Malkeet Singh Tunda alongwith his 5/6 companions and second party headed by Shubham alongwith is 5/6 companions were firing

towards one another with intention to kill each other. If raid is conducted, weapons of offence can be recovered. The offence was made out against accused u/s.307,148,149 of IPC read with section 25 of Arms Act. During investigation, the secret information was received that Pawan Kumar alias Sonu, Amrit Kumar alias Meeta and Kanavpreet Singh were companions of Malkeet Tunda.

7. The FIR was registered on the basis of secret information and even applicant was not named in the FIR. Subsequently, he was named. Accused/applicant in this case was arrested on 3.8.2019 and since then he is in custody. It is a no injury case. Only allegations are that two goons one headed by Tunda and another headed by Shubham are firing against each other with the intention to kill each other. There is no injury to any person. Co-accused have already been released on bail. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the applicant behind the bars as conclusion of trial will take long time. Moreover, nowadays there is a outbreak of Covid-19 and jails are to be decongested. As such, present bail application of applicant-accused is allowed and applicant is admitted to bail subject to his furnishing personal bail bond in the sum of

Rs.1,00,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of Ld.Illaqa/Duty Magistrate and further subject to following terms and conditions:-

1. That accused/applicant shall appear in the court on each and every date of hearing;
2. Accused/applicant will not tamper with the prosecution evidence;
3. Accused/applicant will not leave the country without prior permission of the court.

Main file be returned forthwith. However, before parting with the order, it is further observed that due to outbreak of Covid-19, it may be possible that applicant may not be able to furnish the surety bond as sureties may not be available. So at the time of furnishing of bail bond, applicant may be for the time being, released on furnishing personal bond of the sum ordered above, giving him time to furnish the surety bond, within the stipulated period, so granted by the Court. Bail application file be consigned to record room.
