

‘Raghu alias Raghav Kakkar Versus State’
FIR No.51 dated 23.5.2021 of P.S.Bhikhiwind.
Under Section 457/380 IPC.

The applicant-accused Raghu alias Raghav Kakkar has brought the present application under Section 438 Cr.P.C. with a prayer for the concession of anticipatory bail with the submissions that although he has been falsely implicated in the case, he apprehends his arrest in the above captioned case.

Upon notice of the bail application, the investigating agency has produced records of the case which I have perused carefully and have also heard the learned counsel for the accused-applicant and learned APP for the State.

As per records, the FIR in this case is the outcome of an incident of house tress-pass at night and commission of theft on the intervening night of 7/8.5.2021 which according to the complainant Mukesh Sondhi had been committed by some unknown persons after breaking a part of the roof of his wholesale Karyana and Confectionary shop. He further stated that he had been hunting for the culprits behind the occurrence at his own level and as a result, had stated that it was the present accused who alongwith his co-accused Gurlal Singh son of Bhupinder Singh and Joban son of Satnam Singh had committed the act of house tress at night and the theft of various articles which according to details available in police records, are valued at more than Rs.3 lacs. This being the situation and the complainant having specifically been nominated by name, I am of the considered view that in such a case the concession of anticipatory bail cannot be extended to the accused as the recovery of the stolen articles can be effected only during the course of custodial interrogation of the accused.

Viewing thus, I do not find any ground to extend the concession of anticipatory bail and the application of the accused for the purpose stands dismissed accordingly. Papers be consigned to Record Room.
