BAIL APPLICATION UNDER SECTION 439 Cr.P.C.

ORDER

Applicant has filed the instant bail application under Section 439 of Cr.P.C., seeking regular bail in the above noted case.

2. It is argued by the learned counsel for the applicant that applicant is innocent. He is not committed any offence and he has been falsely implicated in this case. It is submitted that alleged recovery of 50 grams of heroin has been foisted upon the applicant as nothing has been recovered from the accused/applicant as alleged. Applicant is in custody since 03.06.2022. It is submitted that the conclusion of trial is going to take sufficient time. Therefore, it is prayed that the applicant may kindly be granted the concession of regular bail.

3. On the other hand, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State opposed the bail application and prayed that bail may kindly be dismissed.

4. I have considered the contentions raised by both the sides.

5. As per allegations of prosecution, on 03.06.2022 from the conscious possession of applicant 50 grams of heroin was recovered. Recovered quantity of heroin would fall under non-commercial quantity. Applicant is not found to be involved in any other case nor is he found to be previous convict. The applicant is in custody since the date of his arrest on 03.06.2022 and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the applicant behind the bar for an indefinite period as the conclusion of trial is going to take considerable period of time. As such, without commenting anything on the merits of the main case, applicant is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing of bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount. However, it is made clear that observation made herein above shall not be construed as an expression on the merits of main case. The bail application file be consigned to the record room.
