

State of Punjab VS Jaspreet Kaur etc.

Present: Sh. Rajnish Salaria APP for the State.

Smt Kamlesh Rani Advocate for accused Simran Singh and Naina Rani.

Arguments heard on first bail application moved on behalf of accused/applicant Simran Singh and Naina Rani.

Counsel for the accused/applicants submitted that the accused have falsely implicated in this case and they are in custody since 23.12.2020. He further stated that name of accused has not been mentioned in the FIR. So, it is clear that no role has been attributed to the applicants/accused. So no useful purpose will be served to keep the accused behind the bars for such a long period. So accused be released on bail.

On the other hand, Ld APP for the State has opposed the contentions of ld defence counsel and he further stated that accused have committed an offence u/s 365 of IPC. Therefore, he has committed serious offence for which he is not entitled to be released on bail and there is apprehension that if he is released, he may misuse the same. Accordingly, prayer has been made for the dismissal of the bail application.

Heard. Perused. As per contents of the FIR the allegations against the accused are very serious and heinous in nature. There is every apprehension that investigation process would be hampered if the accused are bailed out. In view of the gravity of offence involved, I do not deem it fit to grant bail to the accused persons. Hence, the bail application of accused Simran Singh and Naina Rani stand dismissed.
