This is an application u/s 482 of B.N.S.S. filed by the petitioner namely, Punam Shaw in connection with Kharagpur(T) P.S. Case No.487/2025 dated 23.10.2025 u/s 108 BNS.

Ld. advocate for the petitioner/petitioners submitted that no bail application has either been filed before any Higher Court or any such bail petition has been rejected.

Heard the Ld. Advocate and Ld. P.P in-charge.

Perused the petition, CD as well as the materials available on record.

It appears that the victim committed suicide by hanging himself inside the room. The allegation herein is that of an unsuccessful love affairs that cropped up between the petitioner and the victim boy who committed suicide.

At this juncture I want to refer to the citation of the Hon'ble Apex Court in **Abhinav Mohan Delkar vs. State of Maharashtra and Others** reported in **2025(4) AICLR 385 (SC)** wherein the Apex Court observed that a person unable to bear pressure or withstand a humiliation or unable to oppose, may succumb to extreme act of ending his own life, in desperation but would not necessarily mean that alleged perpetrator had intention to lead victim to eventual death by his own or her own hands.

Admittedly, there was no suicide note nor there is any direct allegation against the petitioner coercing the victim to death by the perpetrator save and except that she demanded money from the victim boy. In view of my above observation, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

In the event of arrest the petitioner named above may find bail of Rs.5000/- with 2 sureties of Rs.2,500/- each subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting officer and with usual condition as laid down u/s 482(2) B.N.S.S.

Misc case is disposed of. CD/TCR, if any, be returned.
