Today is fixed hearing of this case.

This is an **application under Section 482 BNSS corresponding to U/S 438** of the Criminal Procedure Code filed by the accused petitioner **Sk. Ibrahim Ali** in connection with E.C Act Case No. 232/2026, Narayangarh P.S Case No. 46/2026, dated 06.02.2026 U/S 135(1)(a)(b) of the Electricity Act, 2003.

Learned Advocate for the petitioner has submitted that the accused person is law abiding citizen and consumer of domestic electricity and also having a submersible pump with different set up at different places. The petitioner is in no way connected with the commission of alleged offence of illegal and unauthorized consumption of electricity by passing the energy meter of WBSEDCL. So, he is praying for anticipatory bail.

Ld. P.P. in charge, Swarnendu Parial has opposed the prayer for bail and left the matter before the discretion of this Court.

Having heard the Counsel of the parties and having gone through the materials on record, it appears that the accused person has already paid amounting to Rs.110620/- on 08.01.2026 and thereafter one complaint has been lodged against him by the A.E & S.M Narayangarh CCC, WBSEDCL on 06.02.2026 and as per the provisional Assessment Bill of WBSEDCL it appears gross demand of Rs.210834/- which has not yet been paid by the accused person till date and no final assessment copy of bill furnished by the accused person today. Having consideration to the financial condition of the accused person who is a farmer and also having gravity upon the affidavit filed by the accused person, I am inclined to allow this prayer for anticipatory bail filed by the petitioner. Hence, this anticipatory bail prayer made u/sec. 438 Cr.P.C is allowed. The accused petitioner namely **Sk. Ibrahim Ali** may find **interim bail of Rs.2000/-** with one surety of like amount **on condition to remain present before the Court on each and every date fixed and to deposit 50% of the final assessment bill of WBSEDCL within next three months positively i.d this bail order will be cancelled automatically.**

Let a copy of this order be sent to Ld. C.J.M Paschim Medinipur.

Let a copy of this order be forwarded to the A.E & S.M Narayangarh CCC WBSEDCL for necessary compliance.

Inform the accused person to have the final assessment bill from Narayangarh CCC WBSEDCL and to file the same before this Court on the next date fixed of this case i.e. 06.02.2027 positively.

Thus, Misc. Case 02 of 2026 is disposed of on contest.

D.A is directed to tag Cri. Misc. case 02 of 2026 with E.Act no. 232/2026.
