Today is fixed for production of the accused person and hearing of bail petition.

The accused Nabin Barma is produced from MCCH before the court. He is taken into custody and remanded to J.C. till date.

Both the Ld. Special P.P as well as the Ld. Defence Counsel are present.

The bail petition is taken up for hearing.

Ld. Advocate for the accused / petitioner submits that there is a love affair between the accused and the victim girl. He further submits that there is delay in lodging F.I.R. and the delay is not properly explained in the written complaint. The accused person is falsely implicated in this case. There is no chance of absconding and hampering or tampering with the evidence. Accordingly, he prays for bail on any terms and condition.

Ld. Special P.P. raises strong objection.

Heard both sides.

On perusal of the case diary and records, it transpires that the accused is named in F.I.R. The case is at initial stage of investigation. The victim girl is above 17 years old.

Considering the facts and circumstances as well as materials on record this Court is not inclined to release him on bail. Hence, the prayer for bail is considered and **rejected**.
