This is an application u/s 482 of B.N.S.S. filed by the petitioner namely, Aniruddha Roy in c/w Kotwali P.S. Case No. 17/2026 dated 08.01.2026 under section 316(2)/318(4)/115(2)/117(2)/351(2)/3(5) BNS.

Ld. advocate for the petitioner/petitioners submitted that no bail application has either been filed before any Higher Court or any such bail petition has been rejected.

Heard the Ld. Advocate and Ld. P.P.

Ld. P.P submitted that principal accused is wife of this petitioner. The defacto complainant and the wife of this petitioner are employee of same company. He further submitted that there is no document in CD showing any financial transaction with this petitioner. He raised no objection against the bail prayer.

Perused the petition, CD and other materials in case record.

It appears that there is no financial transaction between the petitioner with the defacto complainant except that the accused and his wife on the date of the offence that is on 8.1.2026 assaulted the defacto complainant. Further, on perusal of the CD, no injury report is found. No direct involvement of the accused in the financial transaction is also found. Hence, I find that custodial interrogation of this accused is not required for the purpose of investigation. Accordingly, prayer for anticipatory bail of this petitioner is considered and allowed **with a condition to meet the I.O once in a fortnight till submission of charge sheet.**

In the event of arrest the petitioner named above may find bail of Rs.5000/- with 2 sureties of Rs. 2500/- each subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting officer and with usual condition as laid down u/s 482(2) B.N.S.S.

Misc case is disposed of. CD/TCR, if any, be returned.
