Petition dated: 07.08.2026 filed U/s.483 BNSS to grant bail.

This petition is coming on this day for hearing before me, in the presence of Thiru.P.Kamalakaran, Advocate for the petitioner and Thiru.S.Arunkumar, the Public Prosecutor for the respondent and upon hearing both sides arguments, this Court passed the following :

ORDER

The Petitioner/A1 was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 28.07.2026 for the alleged offences U/s. 123 of BNS and 20(b)(ii)(A), 29(1) and 8(c) of NDPS Act registered by respondent police, seeks bail.

The learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is an innocent and he was falsely implicated in this case and the petitioner has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution, and the petitioner is undergoing

incarceration for the past 14 days and the petitioner is ready to abide by any condition as imposed by the court and prayed to grant bail to the petitioner subject to any conditions.

The learned Public Prosecutor has submitted that while the respondent police engaged in patrolling duty at Erode near Ellaimariyamman temple, they found the petitioner was in possession of Tapentadol Hydrochloride – 100 mg in 27 Nos, for illegal sale. Hence, a case was registered. Properties were secured. Further, he has submitted that investigation has not been completed and the co accused has been filed bail application before the Hon'ble High Court of Madras and the same is pending, hence he strongly opposed to grant bail to the petitioner.

Heard both sides. Records perused and it shows that the date of occurrence took place on 28.07.2026. As per the case of prosecution, while the respondent police engaged in patrolling duty at Erode near Ellaimariyamman temple, they found the petitioner was in possession of Tapentadol Hydrochloride – 100 mg in 27 Nos, for illegal sale. Properties were secured and the co accused has been filed bail application before the Hon'ble High Court of Madras and the same is pending. Further the petitioner is in judicial custody for the past 14 days only. In the above circumstances, considering the serious nature of the offence, investigation has not been completed and the petitioner is in judicial custody for the past 14 days only and considering the strong objection raised by the prosecution, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

In the result, this petition is dismissed.
