

FIR No.89 Dated 12.08.2021,
U/s 61/1/14 of Excise Act. PS Maur

Present :- Ld. APP for the State.

Sh. B.S.Dhaliwal Advocate for the accused applicant Sukhdev Singh.

This order of mine shall dispose of bail application under Section 61/1/14 of Excise Act moved on behalf of the accused-applicant Sukhdev Singh.

The present FIR No.189 dated 12.08.2021 was registered against the accused-applicant on the allegations that on 12.08.2021 police party were on private car in connection with checking of suspected persons at Chowk, near Hariali Pump, Maur Mandi. At about 03.20 PM secret informer gave secret information that Sukhdev Singh @ Sukha son of Chand Singh son of Bogha Singh R/o Jodhpur Pakhar P.S Maur Haryana is habitual of selling illicit liquor at Maur Mandi, on higher prices from Maur Haryana on less prices. Information was reliable, ruqa was sent to the police station through PHG Ram Singh. Then Constable and other police official apprehended him on the basis of the suspicion.

Notice of this bail application was given to the learned APP, who did not file any reply but opposed the bail application orally and record was also summoned.

On the other hand Ld. Defence counsel submitted that accused-applicant Sukhdev Singh has been falsely implicated in this case, no offence is made out against the accused/applicant. It is further submitted that false recovery has been planted upon the accused-applicant by the police at the instance of wine contractor.

Arguments heard and record perused. As per allegations levelled against the accused, accused Sukhdev Singh has committed offence under section 61/1/14 of Excise Act. Accused is already in custody since 12.08.2021. Conclusion of investigation and presentation of challan would take sufficient long time. If the accused is kept behind the bars then it would be a burden on state exchequer. No useful purpose would be served by keeping the accused in custody for indefinite period. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances and in the interest of justice, present bail application stands allowed to the effect that accused Sukhdev Singh is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing his bail bonds in sum

of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in like amount. Bail bonds and surety bonds not furnished. The application stands disposed of. Papers be attached with the remand papers.
