Accused Srimanta Hansda, Sanjoy Murmu, Kishan Murmu and Biswajit Hembram are produced from judicial custody through VC.

Witnesses, Sujata Murmu and Bulti Murmu are present. They are examined and cross-examined as P.W. 5 and P.W. 6. No other witness is present.

Bail petitions filed by the accused persons namely Srimanta Hansda, Sanjoy Murmu, Kishan Murmu and Biswajit Hembram are taken up for hearing.

Learned counsel for the accused Srimanta Hansda and Sanjoy Murmu submits that they are in custody for a long time. Most of the independent witnesses have been examined and they did not support the prosecution case. There is no possibility of influencing the trial. Considering their detention, they may be enlarged on bail imposing any terms and conditions.

Learned counsel for the accused Kishan Murmu and Biswajit Hembram submits that they are in custody for a long time. They were not involved in the alleged incident. They have been implicated in this case falsely. The relatives and friend of the victim did not support of the prosecution case. They shall not abscond from justice. Considering their detention, they may be enlarged on bail imposing any terms and conditions.

Learned Special Public Prosecutor raises objection and submits that the victim has implicated all the accused persons in her evidence and identified them on dock. The bail petition of accused Biswajit Hembram was rejected by the Hon'ble High Court in CRM (M) 680 of 2026 dt. 01.04.2026.

It is a case of gang aggravated penetrative sexual assault. In view of the recent observation of the Hon'ble High Court and taking into consideration the serious nature of the accusation, complicity against them and the evidence already recorded, this Court is not inclined to enlarge them on bail. Their bail prayer is duly considered and rejected.

The accused persons are remanded to J.C. till next date.

To date i.e. on **09.07.2026** for production of the accused persons and further evidence for the prosecution.
