***1st Application for anticipatory bail under section 438 of
Cr.P.C.***

O R D E R

1. This application for anticipatory bail has been filed by applicant/accused, Manjit Singh son of S.Karnail Singh, in case FIR No.44 dated 23.04.2018 for offences under sections 323/324/379/34 of

Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Ramdas, Amritsar.

2. On notice, Public Prosecutor opposed the bail application.

3. I have heard counsel for applicant/accused and the Public Prosecutor for the State and have gone through the record.

4. As per allegations appearing on the record, on 08.04.2018 complainant Amarjit Kaur wife of S.Amarjit Singh was resting in her plot and at that time her daughter-in-law Rajwant Kaur was sitting on the cot at the spot. Then at about 10/11.00 a.m. applicant Manjit singh, Balwinder Singh armed with datar, Mandeep Kaur and Ravinder Singh came there and applicant Manjit Singh raised lalkara and then Balwinder Singh gave datar blow which hit on the right shoulder of complainant. Another datar blow given by Balwinder Singh hit on the upper portion of right arm of complainant. Complainant and Rajwant Kaur raised alarm on which Mandeep Kaur and Ravinder Singh took away shuttering material which was lying in the plot. The other accused also sped away from there alongwith their weapons.

5. As per allegations appearing in the FIR, applicant Manjit Singh was unarmed and he did not cause any injury to anyone at the time of alleged occurrence which took place on 08.04.2018. The FIR was registered in this case on 23.04.2018. The applicant has already

joined the investigation with the police and nothing remains to be recovered from him. So, no purpose will be served even if at this stage the applicant is sent to police custody.

6. Accordingly, this bail application is allowed and order of interim bail dated 01.05.2018 passed by this court is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions which are envisaged under section 438 (2) of Cr.P.C. Papers be consigned to record room.
