The accused persons namely, Rohit Sharma @ Rahul and Pritam Das @ Babu are produced from judicial custody through Video-conferencing.

Today is fixed for production and report in final form.

Report in final form is not received.

One bail petition is filed on behalf of accused persons, namely, Rohit Sharma @ Rahul and Pritam Das @ Babu by Ld. Advocate Sri Anupam Jana along with fresh Vokalatnama.

Copy of bail petition is served to the prosecution.

It is submitted by the Defence that no bail petition of this accused is either pending or was rejected by any higher forum.

It is submitted on behalf of accused Rohit Sharma @ Rahul and Pritam Das @ Babu that they are completely innocent and they are falsely implicated in this case. There is no chance of their absconding and in view of the above it is prayed that they may be enlarged on bail on any condition.

Ld. P.P.-in-Charge, appearing for the State of West Bengal raises objection submitting that Section 37 of N.D.P.S. Act is the bar for bail of the accused persons.

I have carefully considered the materials on record.

I find that commercial quantity of contraband articles were recovered from the possession of these accused persons. The investigation is still in progress. As the commercial quantity of contraband articles were recovered from the possession of these accused persons, I do not find any reason to hold that they are not guilty at this stage by reason of Section 37 of N.D.P.S. Act.

In view of the above, I am not inclined to enlarge these accused persons on bail.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail of these accused persons namely, Rohit Sharma @ Rahul and Pritam Das @ Babu is **rejected**.
