ORDER:

1. Present bail application has been filed by above named
accused/applicant under the provisions of Section 483 BNSS in FIR
No.91 dated 05.06.2025, under Section 21 of NDPS Act, registered at
Police Station City-2 Mansa.
2. Notice of the bail application has been issued to the State.
Learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State has appeared. Record
has been produced.
3. Learned counsel for the accused/applicant submits that the
accused/applicant is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the

present case. Further submits that this is the third bail application as earlier the bail application was dismissed by this Court. Ld. Counsel submits that recovery effected is 5 grams of Heroin as per the prosecution and accused/applicant is behind the bars from last more than five months. Further submits that conclusion of trial will take sufficient long time and even accused/applicant is not in a position to approach the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court for the bail application and thus prays that recovery and the custody may kindly be considered and bail application may kindly be allowed.

4. Ld. Addl. PP for the State submits that in the present case, recovery effected is 5 grams of Heroin from the possession of accused/applicant. Further submits that there are nine more FIRs registered against the applicant/accused. Further submits that earlier, bail application has been dismissed on merits and no ground is made out. It is humbly prayed that the present bail application may kindly be dismissed.

5. After hearing learned counsel for the applicant/accused, learned Addl.PP for the State and perusal of the record, it reflects that in the present case, accused/applicant has been apprehended by the police and from his conscious possession, 5 grams of Heroin has been got recovered. Accused/applicant is behind the bars since 05.06.2025. In the present case, investigation has been completed and challan has been filed on 07.08.2025. Thereafter, charge has been framed on 14.08.2025. Further, Trial Court file reflects that no PW has been examined till date. The recovery effected in the present case is just on the verge of small quantity and the intermediate quantity. Though, as per the prosecution, there are nine more FIRs registered against the applicant/accused and earlier, the bail application has been dismissed by this Court, but at this stage, taken into consideration the fact that accused/applicant is behind the bars from last about six months and recovery is on the verge of small quantity and the intermediate quantity and conclusion of trial will take sufficient long time, this court is of the opinion that no fruitful purpose

would be served by further detaining the applicant/accused behind the bars. Accordingly, the bail application in hand stands allowed and taken into consideration the other number of FIRs registered against the applicant/accused, applicant/accused is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of bail bonds in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/-with one surety in the like amount before the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Judge and further subject to the condition that applicant/accused will neither leave the country without prior permission of the Court, nor applicant/accused will tamper with the evidence nor will put pressure on the witnesses of the prosecution and will appear on each and every date of hearing of the Court. Bail application file be attached with the main file.
