

## Gurdev Kaur @ Debo Vs. State

Present: Ms.Ritu Sharma, Adv., counsel for applicant/accused  
Sh.Balwinder Singh, Id.PP for State.

The Id.counsel for accused has moved present application for bail by submitting that the applicant/accused has been falsely implicated in the present case and she is in judicial custody since 27.7.2019. The alleged recovery has already been effected from the accused and she is no more required for further investigation. The alleged recovery is of 20 gram Heroin which is non commercial quantity. The applicant/accused has not committed any offence. As such, she be released on bail.

It is argued by the Id.counsel for applicant/accused that 20 Gram Heroin has been recovered from the accused. The applicant/accused is in custody since 27.7.2019. Hence, she be released on bail.

On the other hand it is argued by the Id.PP for State that the accused has committed serious offence, so, she may not be released on bail.

I have heard the Id.PP for State and Id.counsel for applicant/accused. The recovery of 20 gram Heroin has been effected from the accused. The report of Chemical Examiner is still awaited. As such, the bail application of applicant/accused is hereby allowed. The applicant/accused is ordered to be released on interim bail on her furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.1.00 lac with one surety of the like amount. The applicant/accused shall surrender before the court if report of Chemical Examiner goes against her. Copy of this order be sent also to the Id.trial court. File be consigned to the record room.
