This is an application u/s 482 of B.N.S.S. filed by the petitioner namely, Subrata Das in c/w Kotwali P.S Case No.248/2026 dtd 26.04.2026 u/s. 126(2)/115(2)/117(2)/109(1)/351(2) BNS.

Ld. advocate for the petitioner/petitioners submitted that no bail application has either been filed before any Higher Court or any such bail petition has been rejected.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioner submits that this petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and he has nothing to do with the alleged offence. Ld. Advocate for the petitioner submits that the section 109(1) BNS is non-bailable and rest sections are triable by the Magistrate and therefore, he prays for anticipatory bail on any terms and conditions.

Ld. P.P. in-charge produced the case diary and leaves the adjudication of the case to the discretion of the Court by pointing out the matters available in the case diary.

Heard the Ld. Advocate and Ld. P.P. in-charge.

Perused the petition, CD and other materials in case record.

Perused the injury report at page 22 of the CD.

Prima facie, it appears that the injuries reflected in the injury report do not corroborate the statements u/s. 180 of BNSS. Considering the materials on record, this court finds no sufficient reason to keep the petitioner behind the bar for custodial interrogation. Hence, prayer for anticipatory bail is considered and allowed **with a condition upon the petitioner to meet the I.O twice in a week till submission of charge sheet and also with a condition that he shall co-operate with the investigating agency and he shall not tamper any evidence and influence the witnesses.**

In the event of arrest the petitioner named above may find bail of Rs.5,000/- with 2 sureties of Rs.2,500/- each subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting officer and with usual condition as laid down u/s 482(2) B.N.S.S.

Misc case is disposed of. CD/TCR, if any, be returned.
