Order No. 1 Dated 27.04.2026

Received a skeleton record with the order dated 26.04.2026 from the Court of the Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Paschim Medinipur.

Perused the order of the ld. C. J. M., Paschim Medinipur.

On perusal it reveals that 1. Vinay Prasad, 2. Ansh Kumar and 3. Manish Kumar were brought under arrest by Kharagpur GRPS u/s 20(b)(ii)(C)/29 of N.D.P.S. Act, 1985

Let the case be registered as N.D.P.S. Case No. 07/2026.

All the above named accused persons are produced physically. They are taken into custody.

A petition for bail is filed on behalf of accused persons.

Heard both sides.

On perusal of the materials on record this Court finds that, 35.589 Kilograms of 'Ganja', has been recovered from the possession of the accused persons. Hence considering the nature and gravity of the offence the prayer for bail stands **rejected**.

The I.O. prays for police custody of the accuseds, namely, 1. Vinay Prasad, 2. Ansh Kumar and 3. Manish Kumar for seven days.

Now the prayer for police custody made by the I.O. is taken up for hearing in respect of the accused, namely, 1. Vinay Prasad, 2. Ansh Kumar and 3. Manish Kumar.

The I.O. is present with the C.D.

The prayer for police custody for seven days is recommended by Deputy Superintendent of Police, G.R.P. Kharagpur.

Ld. P.P.-in-Charge is also present. He submits that, for the sake of investigation the prayer of the I.O. may be allowed.

Perused the C.D. and the statements of the accused persons recorded u/s 180 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.

Considering the nature of the offence and the quantity of the seized article recovered from the accused persons, this Court is of the view that, for the sake of effective investigation the prayer of the I.O. for police custody should be allowed.

Accordingly, the prayer of the I.O. for police custody of the accused namely, 1. Vinay Prasad, 2. Ansh Kumar and 3. Manish Kumar are allowed for **seven days**.

The I.O. is directed not to inflict any physical and mental torture upon the accused persons during the PC period and shall get them medically examined in every 24 hours. The IO is further directed to follow the guidelines issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, during the PC period.

Fix **04.05.2026** for production of the three accused persons from police custody.

Let the custody of the accused persons be handed over to the IO.

The I.O. is directed to remain present before this Court on the date fixed.

Let a copy of this order be handed over to the I.O. Sub-Inspector Subhajit Roy for information and compliance.
