ORDER :

1. The applicant having been detained in custody in the matter of

aforesaid FIR has filed the present applicant for grant of bail u/s 439 Cr. PC. It has been alleged that the petitioner was confined in the jail in the matter bearing FIR No. 267/14, PS Cantonment, Amritsar under NDPS Act and he could not verify the addresses and documents of the alleged sureties. It is submitted that the petitioner is in judicial lock up since long and completion of trial will take time because co-accused are at large and no useful purpose will be served by keeping the accused behind bar. It is accordingly prayed that the applicant be admitted to bail.

2. Notice of the bail application was given to the learned Addl. PP for the State who has appeared and contested the bail application.

3. Police record was also requisitioned and perused.

4. This court has considered the matter. Perusal of the record reveals that a complaint was filed by Mrs. Monika Goyal, Ld. Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar regarding commission of offences under Sections 193/420/120-B/465/466/468/471 IPC. The present applicant was produced by the jail authorities on 25-1-2019 and he is in custody since long. Keeping in view the nature of allegations where the applicant have, in conspiracy with other persons, tried to cheat the court by forging the documents, so that he be released from custody. This court is of the view that it is an offences of most serious nature and it strikes the foundation of criminal justice system and accordingly, in view of the fact that the co-accused are not

traceable, the applicant cannot be extended the concession of bail u/s 439 Cr. PC. The present bail application being devoid of any merits is hereby dismissed. Present bail application be consigned to record room. Trial Court Record be sent back alongwith copy of this order.
