**ORDER**

1. By this order, this Court intends to dispose off the bail application under Section 438 Cr.PC having been filed by applicant

Karanjit Singh.

2. Notice of the bail application was served upon the State through learned Additional PP alongwith copy of bail application, who received the same, appeared and contested the bail application on merits. Police record was also requisitioned which has been received and perused.

3. I have heard the respective submissions of both the sides and carefully gone through the file.

4. This FIR was registered against the applicant/accused on the complaint of prosecutrix after thorough inquiry by the Crime Against Women Cell, Ajnala and report of DSP, Ajnala with the allegations that the applicant was forcing the complainant to solemnize marriage with him failing which she and her younger brother shall be killed at gun point and he is stated to have outraged the modesty of complainant while she used to go to attend her computer classes. The allegations as contained in the complaint are serious and specific in nature and have also been tested through an inquiry by the Crime Against Women Cell, Ajnala. Learned counsel for the applicant has requested for grant of bail to the applicant primarily on the ground of there being delay in registration of FIR but such delay is not attributable to the complainant who has lodged the complaint at the earliest and the time if any was consumed in the inquiry having been conducted by the Crime Against Women Cell, Ajnala as such, no

special case is made out in favour of the applicant for grant of bail under section 438 Cr.PC.

5. Resultantly, the bail application under Section 438 Cr.PC filed by applicant/accused stands dismissed. Police record be returned and the bail application file be consigned to the record room.
