GROUND'S MENTIONED IN THE APPLICATION

2. The instant application for grant of regular bail has been moved on behalf of accused Harbhajan Singh alias Bhajni mainly on the grounds of false implication; nothing being recovered from the applicant/accused; applicant/accused being in custody since 29.07.2023.

NATURE OF OFFENCES IN FIR:

3. Present FIR under Sections 394, 379B, 323, 411,34 IPC has been registered against accused Harbhajan Singh alias Bhajni alongwith

co-accused mainly on the allegations that the accused caused injuries on the person of complainant Gurdeep Singh, snatched his mobile phone make Vivo and Rs.5000/- from his pocket.

ANTECEDENTS OF THE APPLICANT-ACCUSED

4. As per statement of HC Makhan Singh No.770/Mansa, except the present case, no other FIR registered against the applicant/accused.

ARGUMENTS ON BEHALF OF APPLICANT

5. Learned counsel for applicant while reiterating the grounds mentioned in the bail application has further submitted that the allegations are yet to be proved.

ARGUMENTS ON BEHALF OF STATE:

6. Learned Addl.PP for the State while opposing these submissions has argued that taking into consideration the nature and gravity, present bail application may be dismissed.

OPINION:

7. Heard. Record perused. Considering the fact that challan has been presented in the Court; co-accused has already been released on bail; applicant/accused is in custody since 29.07.2023 and trial is likely to take time, this court is inclined to enlarge the applicant/accused on bail. Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the case, applicant/accused Harbhajan Singh alias Bhajni is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- with one surety in the like amount before the Court of learned Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, subject to the condition that the applicant-

accused will regularly appear in the Court on each and every date of hearing, will not commit similar offence in future and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court and if at any stage the applicant-accused jump bail in that case, this order shall be deemed to have been cancelled and other conditions as enumerated under the provisions of Cr.P.C.

8. In case the applicant does not furnish bail bonds and surety bonds in compliance of this order within a period of one month from the date of order, Ahlmad is directed to report with regard to the same so that the undersigned may consider as to whether the conditions of bail require modification or relaxation. Ahlmad is also directed to sent the soft copy of this order by email to the bail applicant through the Jail Superintendent today itself. Ahlmad is directed to send the copy of this bail order to the concerned Court. File be consigned to the record room.
