This is an application u/s 483 of B.N.S.S. filed by the petitioners namely, Ainul Khan and 02 others in c/w Kharagpur (Town) P.S Case No.184/2026 dtd 02.04.2026 u/s. 310(4)/310(5) BNS.

Ld. advocate for the petitioner/petitioners submitted that no bail application has either been filed before any Higher Court or any such bail petition has been rejected.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioners submitted that these accused persons are in custody since 17.05.2026 and other co-accused / petitioners are already on bail. So, considering the detention of the accused / petitioners they may be granted bail on any terms and conditions.

Ld. P.P. in-charge produced the case diary and leaves the adjudication of the case to the discretion of the Court by pointing out the matters available in the case diary.

Heard the Ld. Advocate and Ld. P.P. in-charge.

Perused the petition, CD and other materials in case record.

It appears that co-accused / petitioners on the same footing have already enlarged on bail and there is no recovery from the possession of the accused / petitioners. It further appears that present accused / petitioners are in custody since 17.05.2026. As such, further detention of the accused / petitioners are not necessary for further investigation. Accordingly, the petition for bail is considered and allowed **with a condition upon the petitioners to meet the I.O once in a week till submission of charge sheet and also with a condition that they shall co-operate with the investigating agency and they shall not tamper any evidence and influence the witnesses.**

The petitioners named above may find bail of Rs. 2,000/- each with 2 sureties of Rs.1,000/- each subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court.

Misc case is disposed of. CD/TCR, if any, be returned.
