This is an application u/s 482 of B.N.S.S. filed by the petitioners namely, Dilip Mukherjee and 02 others in c/w Garhbeta P.S. Case No.233/2026 dtd 30.05.2026 u/s. 329(4)/115(2)/117(2)/76/351(2)(3)/3(5) BNS.

Ld. advocate for the petitioner/petitioners submitted that no bail application has either been filed before any Higher Court or any such bail petition has been rejected.

Heard the Ld. Advocate and Ld. P.P. in-charge.

Perused the petition, CD and other materials in case record.

This is a case u/s 76/351(2) of BNS and other bailable Sections of BNS though the case was started u/s 76 of BNS no statement was recorded u/s 183 BNSS of the victim lady. There is a case and counter case in between the parties regarding the self same incident and petitioner no.1 lodged the written complaint earlier than the defacto complainant of this case. Moreover, from the injury report it appears that there is only blunt trauma at multiple sides of the body. So, considering the materials in the CD, I am of the opinion that custodial interrogation of these petitioners is not necessary at this stage. Hence, the petition for anticipatory bail is considered and allowed **with a condition upon the petitioner no.1 will meet the I.O once in a fortnight till completion of charge-sheet.**

In the event of arrest the petitioners named above may find bail of Rs.2,000/- each with 2 sureties of Rs.1,000/- each subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting officer and with usual condition as laid down u/s 482(2) B.N.S.S.

Misc case is disposed of. CD/TCR, if any, be returned.
