ORDER

By this order, this Court shall dispose of two bail applications mentioned above as the same have arisen out of the same FIR.

2. Arguments heard. As per the prosecution allegations, the accused-applicants were found in possession 1000 bottles of country made liquor meant for sale in Chandigarh only on 16.12.2019. Since then they are in custody. The report of Chemical Examiner has not been received. Thus, it is made out that the presentation of challan and thereafter the disposal of the case is likely to take sufficient time. No useful purpose would be served by further detention of the applicants-accused. Under these circumstances, the instant bail applications are allowed and the applicants are ordered to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.One lac with one surety in the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Illaqa/Duty Magistrate, subject to the following conditions:-

1. that the applicants-accused shall not involve themselves in any other offence of similar nature in future.
2. that the applicants shall not leave the country without the prior permission of the Illaqa Magistrate till presentation of challan and thereafter without the permission of the trial court;
3. that the applicants shall not directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
4. that the applicants shall regularly attend the hearings before the trial Court;

In case the applicants misuse the concession of bail by

absenting from the proceedings, the trial Court shall be at liberty to cancel this bail order. The file be consigned to the record room. A copy of this order be placed in the connected bail application titled as “*Prabjit Singh vs State of Punjab*” (BA/199/2020). The files be consigned to the record room.
