

Sonu Vs. State, BA-1988-2025

Heard. As per the report received from the SHO, Police Station Mahilpur, a complaint made by Kuldeep Singh and Kulwant Singh sons of Bishan Singh against the applicant is being inquired into by the police. The accused/applicant has been called by the police to join inquiry proceedings. At this stage, no FIR has been registered against the accused /applicant. Under these circumstances, there is no reasonable apprehension regarding arrest of the accused/applicant. The application is disposed off with the observation that in the event of registration of the FIR, obviously the police would follow the provisions of Section 35(3) and 35(5) of the BNSS, if the same are found applicable. The applicant is at liberty to file fresh application for bail in the event of registration of the FIR. File be consigned to the record room.
