This is an application u/s 482 of B.N.S.S. filed by the petitioners namely, Arati Maity @ Maiti and another in c/w Daspur P.S Case No.318/2026 dated 03.06.2026 u/s. 85/115(2)/109(1)/76/316(2)/3(5) BNS and 3/4 D.P. Act.

Ld. advocate for the petitioner/petitioners submitted that no bail application has either been filed before any Higher Court or any such bail petition has been rejected.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioners submits that these petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case and the allegations against them are general in nature. Ld. Advocate for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners are the in-laws of the victim. Therefore, they pray for anticipatory bail on any terms and conditions.

Ld. P.P in-charge produces the case diary and leaves the adjudication of the case to the discretion of the Court by pointing out the matters available in the case diary.

Heard the Ld. Advocate and Ld. P.P. in-charge.

Perused the petition, CD and other materials in case record.

On perusal of the materials available on the case diary, it appears that the allegations against them are general in nature. As such, this court finds no sufficient reason to keep the petitioners behind the bars for custodial interrogation. Hence, prayer for anticipatory bail is considered and allowed.

In the event of arrest the petitioners named above may find bail of Rs.2,000/- each with 2 sureties of Rs.1,000/- each of like amount subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting officer and with usual condition as laid down u/s 482(2) B.N.S.S.

Misc case is disposed of. CD/TCR, if any, be returned.
