ORDER

Police record is produced. Heard. As per prosecution allegations, on 17.12.2017, on the basis of a secret information, the police party headed by ASI Sukhdev Singh of P.S. Kotwali, Nabha held nakabandi at Bauran Gate, Nabha. At about 6.15 p.m., one car bearing registration No.PB-11-CK-7759 came from the side of bus stand, Nabha which was got stopped. From the search of the said car, 12 boxes each containing 12 bottles of country made liquor make 'Santra, Chandigarh' total 144 bottles were recovered. Accused Gurdeep Singh son of Karnail Singh was driving the said car, who could not produce any permit or licence for keeping the above said bottles of liquor in his possession. The Investigating Officer put the entire liquor into one drum and then took out one nip from the same as sample. Thereafter, the entire case property was taken into police

possession. During interrogation, accused Gurdeep Singh disclosed that the above said bottles of liquor were brought in his car by the present applicant, who alighted from the car at Patiala Gate, Nabha. Upon this, the present applicant has also been nominated in the present case. On the basis of the ruqa sent by ASI Sukhdev Singh, the present case has been registered at P.S. Kotwali, Nabha against both the accused.

It has been contended by the Ld. counsel for the applicant-accused that the applicant-accused is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present case. The alleged recovery has already been effected and as such, the present applicant-accused is not required for any custodial interrogation. It has been further contended that the applicant-accused is ready to join the investigation and co-operate with the same and as such, his custodial interrogation is not required in this case.

In view of the above said facts and circumstances of the case, since the alleged recovery has already been effected and the applicant is ready to join the investigation and co-operate with the same, therefore, his custodial interrogation is not required at this stage. As such, the applicant/accused is directed to join the investigation within seven days from today and co-

operate with the same and on his doing so, in the event of his arrest, he shall be admitted to interim anticipatory bail on his furnishing bail bond/surety bond to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/I.O./SHO concerned. File be put up on 17.01.2018 for submitting the compliance report. Police record be also produced on that date.
