State of Punjab Vs Ramandeep Singh alias Ramna

1. Ld. APP has put in appearance on behalf of the State and he opposed the bail application without filing any reply and prayed for dismissal of the same.

2. Heard. Original file perused. Perusal of record reveals that during trial accused Ramandeep Singh alias Ramna did not appear in the Court without any intimation on 05.02.2024. As such, his bail order and bonds were cancelled by the Court and he was ordered to be summoned through non-bailable warrant of arrest. Subsequently, on 22.01.2025 accused was produced by the police in response to non bailable warrant of arrest, since then he is in custody. No doubt, accused had misused the concession of bail already granted to him in the present case, but it cannot be ignored that applicant/accused is in custody since 22.01.2025 and he must have learnt a lesson for absenting himself from the Court during trial, during the said custody period. Furthermore, the conclusion of the trial is likely to take considerable time. Moreover, the presence of the accused can be procured by imposing strict conditions in the bail order. As such, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the accused behind bars for indefinite period. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and in the interest of justice, applicant/accused Ramandeep Singh alias Ramna is ordered to be admitted on bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.25,000/- with two **local** sureties in the like

amount each, subject to following conditions:-

1. That the applicant/accused shall appear on each and every date of hearing at sharp 10.00 a.m. and failure of the accused without any intimation on any date of hearing will automatically result in cancellation of his bail/surety bonds.
2. That the applicant/accused shall immediately inform about the change of his address as well as any of the sureties.
3. That the applicant/accused shall not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.
4. That the applicant/accused shall furnish his identity proof i.e. attested copy of Aadhaar Card along-with the mobile numbers.

Bail bonds not furnished. Papers be tagged with main case file.
