

Jaswinder Singh Vs State of Punjab

Arguments on bail application moved by applicant/accused Jaswinder Singh under section 439 Cr.P.C in this case bearing **FIR no.48 dated 12.04.2019 under Section 18 of NDPS Act,1985 Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar**, heard. Record is perused.

As per allegations of the prosecution, **50 gram Opium** was recovered from the possession of applicant/accused. He was arrested on **12.04.2019** and has been remanded to judicial custody since **13.04.2019**. The recovery effected from the accused i.e. 50 gram Opium which falls under non-commercial quantity and as such, this bail application is not hit by Section 37 of NDPS Act. Challan has not been presented so far. The presentation of challan and thereafter its disposal will take time. No useful purpose would be served to keep the applicant/accused behind the bar for an indefinite period as rather it amounts to burden on State exchequer. Therefore, bail application is allowed and the applicant/accused is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of this Court, with the conditions that applicant/accused will neither leave the country without prior permission of the Court nor he will tamper with the witnesses of the prosecution and he will appear before the Court on each and every date of hearing. Record of this bail application be tagged with the remand papers.
