This is an application u/s 482 of B.N.S.S. filed by the petitioners namely, Haridas Mandal and 06 others in c/w Salboni P.S Case No.101/2026 dtd 16.05.2026 u/s. 329(3)/115(2)/118(2)/109(1)/74/324(4)/303(2)/351(2)/3(5) BNS.

Ld. advocate for the petitioner/petitioners submitted that no bail application has either been filed before any Higher Court or any such bail petition has been rejected.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioners submits that these petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case and there is a case and counter case between the parties. Therefore, they pray for anticipatory bail on any terms and conditions.

Ld. P.P. in-charge produces the case diary and leaves the adjudication of the case to the discretion of the Court by pointing out the matters available in the case diary.

Heard the Ld. Advocate and Ld. P.P. in-charge.

Perused the petition, CD and other materials in case record.

Perused the injury reports at pages 21 to 24 in the CD.

Considering the materials available on record, in my opinion, custodial detention for the purpose of interrogation is not necessary. Hence, prayer for anticipatory bail is considered and allowed **with a condition upon the petitioners to meet the I.O once in a week till submission of charge sheet and also with a condition that they shall co-operate with the investigating agency and they shall not tamper any evidence and influence the witnesses.**

In the event of arrest the petitioners named above may find bail of Rs.4,000/- each with 2 sureties of Rs.2,000/- each subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting officer and with usual condition as laid down u/s 482(2) B.N.S.S.

Misc case is disposed of. CD/TCR, if any, be returned.
