This is an application u/s 483 of B.N.S.S. filed by the petitioner namely, Tarak Sing in c/w Kotwali P.S Case No. 212/2026 dtd 25.03.2026 u/s. 329(4)/115(2)/117(2)/109(1)/74/351(2)/3(5) of BNS.

Ld. advocate for the petitioner/petitioners submitted that no bail application has either been filed before any Higher Court or any such bail petition has been rejected.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioner submits that there is no direct allegation against the petitioner for the alleged offences. There is no ingredient of section 109(1) of the BNS. He further submits that the petitioner has been languishing in judicial custody since 24.05.2026 and further detention is not required for the investigation. Therefore, he prays for bail on any terms and conditions.

De facto complainant entered his appearance through an Advocate by filing a duly executing vokalatnama. Ld. Advocate for the de facto complainant raises strong objection for bail.

Ld. P.P. in-charge draws the attention of the Court to the injury reports available in the case diary and leaves the adjudication of the case to the discretion of the Court.

Heard the Ld. Advocate and Ld. P.P. in-charge.

Perused the materials available on the case diary including the injury report.

Considering the nature of the injury sustained by the victim this Court finds no justified reason to enlarge the petitioner on bail at this stage. Accordingly, prayer for bail stands **rejected**.

Misc case is disposed of. CD/TCR, if any, be returned.
