This is an application u/s 482 of B.N.S.S. filed by the petitioner namely, Kapil Das in c/w Debra P.S Case No.285/2026 dtd 30.05.2026 u/s. 85/115(2)/109/351(2) BNS.

Ld. advocate for the petitioner/petitioners submitted that no bail application has either been filed before any Higher Court or any such bail petition has been rejected.

Heard the Ld. Advocate and Ld. P.P. in-charge.

Perused the petition, CD and other materials in case record and the document submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner.

It appears from the documents submitted by the petitioner that on earlier occasion also another Criminal Case u/s 498A IPC was filed by the same defacto complainant in which this petitioner was acquitted and subsequently this case was filed against the same petitioner only to harass him. The marriage took place 15 years back and both were residing separately. It further appears that another documents submitted by the petitioner that this petitioner was assaulted by the family members of the victim lady and the petitioner was treated as Debra Super Specility Hospital. Considering the above aspects, I am of the opinion that custodial interrogation of this petitioner is not necessary at this stage. Hence, the petition for anticipatory bail is considered and allowed **with a condition upon the petitioner will meet the I.O once in a week till submission of the charge-sheet.**

In the event of arrest the petitioner named above may find bail of Rs.2,000/- with 2 sureties of Rs.1,000/- each subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting officer and with usual condition as laid down u/s 482(2) B.N.S.S.

Misc case is disposed of. CD/TCR, if any, be returned.
