Today is fixed for hearing of the Misc. Case.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioner files an affidavit stating that at the time of filing of this case the name of the petitioner has been written as Sujoy Biswas instead of Sushil Biswas and he prayed for correction of the name of the petitioner.

Heard. Perused the affidavit.

The proposed rectification is formal in nature. The prayer for rectification of name of the petitioner is allowed.

The record is taken up for hearing.

This is an application u/s 482 of B.N.S.S. filed by the petitioner namely, Sushil Biswas in c/w Kharagpur(L) P.S Case No.451/2026 dtd 29.05.2026 u/s. 109(1)/316(2)/115(2)/76/351(2)/3(5) BNS.

Ld. advocate for the petitioner/petitioners submitted that no bail application has either been filed before any Higher Court or any such bail petition has been rejected.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioner submits that this petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and there is a civil dispute between the parties. Therefore, he prays for anticipatory bail on any terms and conditions.

Ld. P.P. in-charge produces the case diary and leaves the adjudication of the case to the discretion of the Court by pointing out the matters available in the case diary.

Heard the Ld. Advocate and Ld. P.P. in-charge.

Perused the petition, CD and other materials in case record.

Prima facie, it appears that there are insufficient incriminating materials against the present petitioner. As such, in my opinion, custodial detention for the purpose of interrogation is not necessary. Hence, prayer for anticipatory bail of the present petitioner is considered and allowed.

In the event of arrest the petitioner named above may find bail of Rs.2,000/- with 2 sureties of Rs.1,000/- each subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting officer and with usual condition as laid down u/s 482(2) B.N.S.S.

Misc case is disposed of. CD/TCR, if any, be returned.
