This is an application u/s 483 of B.N.S.S. filed by the petitioners namely, Maheswar Mahananda and another in c/w Garhbeta P.S Case No.94/2026 dtd 26.02.2026 u/s. 115(2)/117(2)/118(2)/351(2)/3(5) of BNS.

Ld. advocate for the petitioner/petitioners submitted that no bail application has either been filed before any Higher Court or any such bail petition has been rejected.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioners submitted that these accused / petitioners are in custody since 27.05.2026. So, considering the detention of the accused persons they may be granted bail on any terms and conditions.

Ld. P.P. in-charge produces the case diary and leaves the adjudication of the case to the discretion of the Court by pointing out the matters available in the case diary.

Heard the Ld. Advocate and Ld. P.P. in-charge.

Perused the petition, CD and other materials in case record.

Perused the injury report at page 32 in the CD and I have also perused the medical document at page 24 of the CD.

On perusal of the materials available in the CD, it appears that the present accused / petitioners are languishing in judicial custody since 27.05.2026. Considering the period of detention undergone by the accused persons, I am inclined to allow the bail prayer of these petitioners. Accordingly, the petition for bail is considered and allowed **with a condition upon the petitioners to meet the I.O once in a week till submission of charge sheet and also with a condition that they shall co-operate with the investigating agency and they shall not tamper any evidence and influence the witnesses.**

The petitioners named above may find bail of Rs. 2,000/- each with 2 sureties of Rs.1,000/- each subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. ACJM, Garhbeta, Paschim Medinipur.

Misc case is disposed of. CD/TCR, if any, be returned.
