**ORDER**

1. This order of mine shall dispose of second application for regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C moved by accused/applicant Yashpal Singh in case FIR No. 26 dated 22.02.2024 for offence under Section 21(a) of NDPS Act, PS Adampur, District Jalandhar, wherein he has been allegedly apprehended with 04 grams of Heroin.

2. Learned counsel for the accused/applicant pressed for regular bail on the ground that the accused/applicant has been falsely implicated in this case, though nothing has been recovered from him. He further argued that the investigating agency has not complied with mandatory provisions of NDPS Act. He further pressed that no useful purpose would be served by further detaining accused/applicant into custody for an indefinite period. He prayed for bail on these grounds.

3. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor opposed the bail application and prayed for dismissal of same.

4. I have heard the learned counsel for the accused/applicant, learned Addl.P.P for the State and have gone through the record.

5. After hearing their rival submissions and perusal of record reveals the fact that on 22.02.2024 the police party headed by SI Premjit Singh have allegedly apprehended co-accused Deepak Gill with 94 intoxicant tablets, whereas accused/applicant Yashpal Singh was allegedly found in possession of 04 grams of heroin, which falls in non commercial category. The completion of investigation, presentation of challan and conclusion of trial would take long time, therefore no useful purpose would be served by detaining the accused/applicant for an indefinite period as pretrial detention would never be considered in the interest of justice. As such, present bail application is hereby allowed and accused-applicant **Yashpal Singh** is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing of bail bonds in the sum of Rs.30,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of this Court/ learned Presiding Officer on duty.

6. However, any observation given in this order shall not effect on merits of the main case. Attested copy of order be retained alongwith remand papers by the Ahlmad, whereas bail application file be consigned to the Record Room after due compilation.
