This is an application u/s 482 of B.N.S.S. filed by the petitioners namely, Ajmira Bibi and 02 others in c/w Kharagpur(L) P.S case No.455/2026 dated 30.05.2026 u/s. 329(3)/117(2)/118(2)/109(1)/351(2)/79/3(5) BNS.

Ld. advocate for the petitioner/petitioners submitted that no bail application has either been filed before any Higher Court or any such bail petition has been rejected.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioners submits that these petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case and they have nothing to do with the alleged offence. There is no ingredient of section 109(1) and 118(2) BNS and rests sections are triable by the Magistrate and therefore, they pray for anticipatory bail on any terms and conditions.

Ld. P.P in-charge produces the case diary and draws the attention of the Court to the report given by M.S.V.P., M.M.C.H. and raises no objection for anticipatory bail.

Heard the Ld. Advocate and Ld. P.P.

Perused the petition, CD and other materials in case record.

It appears that except section 109(1) and 118(2) of BNS rests of the offences are triable by the Magistrate. There is no sufficient materials to attract sections 109(1)/118(2) of BNS.

On perusal of the materials available on the case diary, I do not find a justified reason to detain the petitioners behind the bars for custodial interrogation. Hence, prayer for anticipatory bail is considered and allowed.

In the event of arrest the petitioners named above may find bail of Rs.2,000/- each with 2 sureties of Rs.1,000/- each of like amount subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting officer and with usual condition as laid down u/s 482(2) B.N.S.S.

Misc case is disposed of. CD/TCR, if any, be returned.
