ORDER:

1) Record received. Heard. It is mentioned in the instant bail application that accused/ applicant has been falsely implicated in this case and he has not committed any offence; nothing incriminating has been recovered from him and the alleged recovery has been planted upon the accused/ applicant. It is further averred that the accused/ applicant is in custody since 26.03.2026; presentation of challan and conclusion of trial will take long time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the applicant in custody. Hence, it is prayed that applicant/accused may kindly be released on bail.

2) Learned counsel for the applicant/accused while arguing in the lines of bail application contended that same may be allowed.

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3) Conversely, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State contended that there are serious allegations against the applicant/ accused and therefore, bail application may be dismissed.

4) After hearing rival submissions, it has transpired that instant case FIR was registered when on 26.3.2026, accused/ applicant was apprehended and from him, 6.06 gm heroin was recovered, which is non-commercial quantity. Chemical examiner report is yet to be received. Accused is no more required for custodial interrogation. Presentation of challan and conclusion of trial shall take considerable long time and no useful purpose will be served by keeping the applicant/ accused behind bars. As such, instant bail application is allowed and applicant/ accused is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of Illaqa/ Duty Magistrate with the condition that applicant/ accused will neither leave the country without prior permission of the Court nor she will tamper with the witnesses of the prosecution and he will appear before the learned trial Court on each and every date of hearing. Record be returned. Bail application file be attached with remand papers/ main file.
