ORDER:

1. Record received. Heard. It is mentioned in the instant bail application that applicant/accused has been falsely implicated in the present case by the police of P.S City Sunam. It is further averred that the allegations as alleged in the FIR against applicant are totally false and without any base. It is further averred that investigation against applicant has already been completed and applicant is no more required for the purpose of investigation and nothing is required to be recovered from

applicant. It is further averred that conclusion of trial will take long time and no useful purpose will be served by detaining the accused/applicants in custody. Hence, it is prayed that bail application may kindly be allowed.

2. Learned counsel for the applicant/accused while arguing in the lines of bail application contended that same may be allowed.

3. Conversely, learned Addl. Public Prosecutor for the State contended that there are serious allegations against the accused/applicant and therefore, bail application may be dismissed.

4. After hearing rival submissions, it has transpired that instant case FIR was registered on the statement of one Ravi Singh that on 09.11.2024, he was going back on his motor cycle. When he reached near Kularan turn, then 2/3 persons came out from the bushes, who accosted him. One of them hit Ravi Singh on his face with iron rod and they also snatched his mobile phone. Ravi Singh got fainted and on regaining senses, he went nearby petrol pump, where he called his neighbor Ravi. He was taken to Civil Hospital, Sunam, where he was referred to Rajindra Hospital, Patiala. On recording this statement, police machinery swung into action and instant case FIR was registered.

5. Record reveals that accused in connivance with each other by their alleged act committed serious offence and therefore keeping in view the gravity of allegations, no ground is made out to extend the

benefit of bail to accused/applicant. Resultantly, instant bail application is ordered to be dismissed. Record be returned. Bail application file be consigned to the record room.
